PG Scholarship AICTE Disbursement Rules - 2015

- 1. The student must have 100% attendance for scholarship except for the leaves available to him/her.
- 2. The students must not have any reappear in any subject for continuation of scholarship. Any reappear will result in discontinuation of scholarship till he clears the reappear. The continuation will be from the month in which he/she clears the reappear.
- 3. The scholarships may be discontinued at any time for kind of misconduct by the student receiving the same as judged by a disciplinary committee of the institution.
- 4. It will be obligatory for every post-graduate student to undertake work related to teaching and research activities as assigned to him/her by the Institute. This could include tutorials, laboratory classes, development and maintenance of laboratories, assistance in research and development activities undertaken by faculty members, maintenance and operation of computers and other central facilities, assistance in library etc. The same has to be certified by the F/I of concerned department.
- 5. During the course of studies, the student shall not receive any emoluments, Scholarship, salary, stipend etc. from any other source.
- 6. In no case will the scholarship be allowed for a period of more than 24 months or till thesis submission whichever be the earlier.
- 7. The student shall be entitled for leave for a maximum period of 30 days per academic year (July-June) in addition to general holidays but is not entitled to vacations i.e., summer, winter etc. They need to apply leave forwarded through M.Tech Coordinator. Further Director, UIET/Vice Chancellor, Kurukshetra University may in very hard and exceptional cases allow leave for a period not exceeding 10 days.
